



## Activating and Practical Methods throughout the Learning Path



### Productive Learning (PL) for Newcomers

*Productive Learning* is an educational form that combines learning in school and learning at self-chosen practice sites. It was inspired by the City-As-School New York and developed in the framework of a developmental project with partners from ten countries starting in the 1990<sup>th</sup>. In Germany the model is used in about 100 schools in seven states. The *International Network of Productive Learning Projects and Schools (INEPS)* connects about 50 partners from 15 countries in Europe and the US using the methods in formal and non-formal education.

The workshop will offer

- a short overview and an introduction to the curricular structure and the basic methods of *PL*,
- some activities to join and “test” methods of *Productive Learning* by yourself,
- a choice of “chances and challenges” of activity-based education to invite the participants to discuss and include own experiences,
- some results form (internal and external) evaluation according to the interests in the group.
