




Outcomes of online PD sessions

- **The price** of a webinar is TBC.





How to motivate students



Activating teaching methods






Pedagogy for large groups

Introduction to team learning




Finnish STEAM education represents an innovative, multidisciplinary and collaborative approach to understanding the world around us. In this training Finnish STEAM education is described by real examples of teachers' own projects. You will learn how Finnish innovative STEAM education is implemented in practice.

Depending on the number of online sessions, you will get practical examples of different kind of STEAM projects: e.g. coding, easy electronics, biology and sustainable development, basic level robotics, 3D printing, learning by gaming with Minecraft etc. Moreover, you will get ideas how to plan your own STEAM project and how to assess it.


Outdoor Learning and Art in STEAM projects



Teaching coding the Finnish way



Computational thinking skill is about understanding problem-solving processes, and it is best learned by coding. In addition, coding helps students to learn critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, teamwork, perseverance, and planning. Having children learn coding prepares them for the complex and unpredictable future.


Promoting young children's learning in practice

Participants will get an introduction to the Finnish lesson planning tool, LessonApp, which guides teachers to design better lessons based on Finnish pedagogy.


